When it comes to doing business, Hong Kong is the ideal hub for entrepreneurs to jumpstart their ventures. Indeed, the city has all the ingredients to foster their success – economic freedom, a pro-business government, multiple resources for startups, an international talent pool, low and simple tax regime – and most importantly, a booming startup community with which to explore the opportunities to grow your business regionally or globally. In late 2014, InvestHK conducted a survey on Hong Kong's startup ecosystem. An online questionnaire was completed by 27 target respondents (23 co-work spaces and four incubators). The data collected was based on the knowledge and membership information maintained by the co-work spaces/incubators. Here's a summary of our research findings:





OFFICE LOCATIONS



Of these 1,115 entrepreneurs, 532 of them (48%) founded their startups in public funded co-work spaces/incubators; while 583 of them (52%) are based in private facilities.
