

In its latest **Budget for 2023/24** the HKSAR Government presented a clear direction ahead of driving high quality development through innovation and technology, and the ambition of charting Hong Kong in moving full steam towards the vision of an international I&T centre.

To step up investments in tech startups, the Government will:

- Reserve **HK\$265 million** for Cyberport to nurture smart living startups
- Inject **HK\$400 million** through Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks (HKSTP) into its Corporate Venture Fund to support high potential tech startups
- Allocate an additional **HK\$110 million** for HKSTP to launch its Co acceleration Programme to facilitate growth of startups into regional and global enterprises

In addition, to **build a competitive and sustainable ecosystem** in Hong Kong for attracting top notch startups, the Government will also:

- Introduce a “**patent box**” tax incentive to encourage creation of patented inventions
- Earmark **HK\$50 million** to expedite development of the Web3 ecosystem
- Set up a Green Technology and Finance Development Committee to formulate long term action agenda for developing **GreenTech** and **GreenFi**
